

Hearing postponed

SAN BERNARDINO — The sixth day of the preliminary hearing for Michael Iwakiri, charged in the 1977 murder of a San Bernardino woman and the kidnapping of her two children, was postponed here Monday until today.

Defense attorney Edward P. Foley said he needed to listen to part of a two-hour taped interview with a witness in the case, Rebecca Boyer, of Boise, Idaho, who was questioned in February by San Bernardino Police Detective Don Meyer.

In addition, Chief Deputy Dis-

trict Attorney Joseph Canty was called out of town Monday because of a family medical emergency.

Iwakiri, 31, of Boise, is charged with perjury and accessory to murder and kidnapping. Beverly Wise, 26, was found stabbed to death in her home March 30, 1977, and her two children, Brandi Jondell Summers, then 5 years old, and Tiffani Wise, then 2, were gone. The children have never been found.

The hearing will resume today at 10 a.m. in Municipal Court, department E.
