occur and why he is waiting.

Summers, 39, is in an Oregon jail where he is serving a year's sentence after being convicted last week of a misdemeanor assault against his wife, Connie. In the assault last fall her arm was so badly broken that doctors have said it will have to be amputated. She has since divorced Summers.

Summers has waived extradition to California and will stand trial here before he serves his full sentence in Oregon. San Bernardino authorities expect to bring him here in two to three weeks.

In addition to Casner, Summers and Carino, a Boise, Idaho, couple, Mike and Juanita Iwakiri, have been charged in the case.

Mike Iwakiri, 31, is in San Bernardino County Jail on \$100,000 bail on charges of perjury and accessory to murder and kidnapping. He was arrested after testifying before the San Bernardino County Grand Jury two weeks ago. His preliminary hearing is scheduled to begin Monday in Municipal Court.

Juanita Iwakiri, 27, was charged in Boise with what would be the equivalent in California of felony child concealment. She was released on her own recognizance.
