

Hearing postponed

SAN BERNARDINO — A bail reduction hearing for Michael Iwakiri, charged in connection with the 1977 murder of a San Bernardino woman and the kidnapping of her two daughters, was postponed Thursday until next week because a new attorney was appointed to represent him.

Iwakiri, 31, of Boise, Idaho, is charged with accessory to both kidnapping and murder and with perjury because investigators believe he lied when testifying last week before the county grand jury. He is in county jail and with

bail set at \$100,000.

Donald W. Jordan Jr., appointed to represent Iwakiri at his arraignment Tuesday, told Municipal Court Judge Dan Rankins Thursday that he doesn't have enough time to handle the case.

He told Rankins that Iwakiri couldn't afford to hire counsel on his own, so the judge relieved Jordan and named local attorney Edward P. Foley to represent the defendant.
