

# Summers appearance postponed

SAN BERNARDINO — Arraignment for Roy Summers, charged in the 1977 murder of his ex-wife here and the abduction of her two daughters, was postponed Wednesday for one week because Summers wanted to confer with his attorney.

Summers, 39, was extradited Tuesday from Oregon where he had been serving a year's jail sentence on an unrelated charge.

Beverly Wise, 26, was discovered stabbed to death March 30, 1977, at her home and her girls, Brandi Jondell Summers, then 5, and Tiffani Wise, then 2, were missing, apparently taken by the killer. Summers is Brandi's father.

The children have never been found, but have reportedly been seen in the last three years in various parts of the west, including in northern California in February.

Summers' attorney is David Weiner of Placerville.
