

Kidnap testimony

Evidence presented at a Boise, Idaho, hearing disclosed that a woman there took care of two young kidnapped San Bernardino sisters off and on between April 1977 and August 1979, it was learned Thursday.

Witnesses testifying at the closed preliminary hearing for Juanita Iwakiri said they first saw Brandi Jondell Summers and Tiffani Wise with her not long after the girls were abducted on March 30, 1977, the day their mother, Beverly Wise, was found slain.

Iwakiri, 27, is charged with what would be the equivalent in California of felony child concealment.

Initially, San Bernardino and Boise investigators believed she had babysat the sisters between last June and August. Brandi was 5 years old and Tiffani was 2 when they were taken.

Sources said Thursday that because of the testimony, Boise Magistrate Judge Richard A. Grant on Wednesday accepted a motion by Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Greg Bower to amend the original
