

Hypnotized Neighbors Give Data on Slaying, Kidnapers to Police

SAN BERNARDINO, Calif. (UPI) — Police hypnotized neighbors of a slain women to make a drawing of suspects in her slaying and the kidnaping of her two children, one of whom suffers cystic fibrosis.

Two neighbors of Beverly Wyse, 26, were hypnotized for four hours during the weekend. From details they provided, police artists made profile and full-face drawings of two men seen near the home.

The drawings were to be distributed today throughout the Western states.

Mrs. Wyse was found dead in her home March 30. Her children, Tiffany, 2, and Brandi Summers, 5, who needs constant medication for her cystic fibrosis, were kidnaped.

Witnesses said they saw the men two hours apart on the same day near the Wyse home.
